THE SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA CONSORTIUM FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF INNOVATIVE RESEARCH AND CARE IN SEPSIS (STAIRS) SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY SPONSORED BY THE FEDERAL MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND RESEARCH, GERMANY CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS.

The sub-Saharan Africa consortium for the Advancement of Innovative Research and Care in Sepsis (STAIRS) builds upon longstanding existing groundwork and African-German cooperation to conduct high-quality research addressing critical knowledge gaps in the epidemiology, diagnosis and quality care of patients with sepsis, across seven African countries (Uganda, Ethiopia, Democratic Republic of Congo, Mozambique, Ghana, Sierra Leone and Nigeria).

Studentships at the MSc level are being offered across the network with the goal of establishing a network of mentored early career researchers who aim to address issues related to sepsis within their settings and beyond.

The STAIRS-Uganda Scholarship aims to support outstanding students pursuing a **Master's Degree in Public Health (MPH) or a Master's Degree in Clinical Epidemiology and Biostatistics (MSc CEB)** at any university in Uganda, who are dedicated to research in sepsis.

Scholarship Coverage:

Full tuition coverage + additional benefits

Criteria for Selection:

1. Must be a first-year student admitted to one of the above Master's degree programs in a Ugandan University.
2. Must have completed a Bachelor's degree in any related field.
3. Demonstrated interest in research and public health on **sepsis**.
4. Willingness to conduct a rigorously mentored dissertation project in this area as part of the degree program.
5. Commitment to develop and maintain a productive career devoted to research in sepsis.
6. Agreement to conform to the rules and regulations of the training institutions and maintain in good standing with the institution.
7. At least 2 years' experience working in a full-time research project (Attach letter of recommendation from work supervisor)
