Selection Criteria:

- Applicants should be on a Master's program for at least One(1) year and should be on Normal Progress.
- Should be a Masters' student in any of the following courses: Social Sciences, Clinical Medicine (Paediatrics, Internal Medicine, Psychiatry, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Surgery), Social Sciences and Public Health.
- Students who can nest their study in an ongoing prospective study following up patients with sickle cell disease are encouraged to apply.

Research Programs:

The following are the broad EnRICH Research priority areas (Themes) and applicants are encouraged to develop research concepts in the areas of; Biomedical, Clinical, Psychosocial, Ethics in addition to a formal masters' program training, trainees will receive training in Bio-ethics, Implementation science, Behavioral sciences research, qualitative and Quantitative

research methodology, Data analysis and Research management.

- Quality of research and Research project approach
- Feasibility of study
- Ethics and Human subjects' protection
